Bridport water restrictions lifted

TasWater has lifted the Stage 1 water restrictions in Bridport.

The restrictions were put in place in mid-December to reduce non-essential water use over the busy summer holiday period.

“Thank you to the Bridport community for their efforts to conserve water over the past two months,” TasWater Corporate and Community Relations General Manager Juliet Mercer said.

“It has been a very hot and dry summer period so even though the restrictions will be lifted on Monday we encourage all Tasmanians to continue to keep their water use down.
