TasWater improving water access for Coles Bay

Contractors have completed work on the installation of a new water filling station at Coles Bay.

It is located approximately 500 meters north of Coles Bay, on an access track off Coles Bay Road and will provide water from the Coles Bay Water Treatment Plant.

Residents without reticulated water will be able to supplement their onsite water supplies via council registered water carters.

TasWater's General Manager Service Deliver Bennie Smith says like much of Tasmania, the Coles Bay area has received little rain over summer to top up water tanks.

"This has led many homeowners to call in water caters with the closest supply at Bicheno, adding significantly to the cost of transport."

"The new filling station on site at Coles Bay will provide easier access to a local supply," Mr Smith said.

More than 2,000 customers use water filling stations around the state and TasWater is investing in electronic metering at each location.

TasWater is also upgrading Bicheno's water filling station and planning a new filling station at Swansea.
