TasWater launches poster competition for primary school students

TasWater is calling on all primary school students to start getting creative and design a poster and enter the National Water Week Poster Competition.

The theme for this year is 'It's time to change the world.'

TasWater Education Officer Kate Beard said National Water Week encourages everyone to build awareness around the value of water as a precious but finite resource.

"Access to clean water is really important to every part of our lives, not just here in Tasmania but we also need to think about water use as part of a global community," Kate said.

Poster competition prizes will include a gift card to the value of \$100 as well as other great prizes.

This year an additional prize is on offer, any school that enters the poster competition will also go into the draw to win \$250.

Students should prepare posters on an A3 piece of paper and send their entry to TasWater by Monday, 9 September 2019.

The competition has categories for Prep, Grade 1 and 2, Grade 3 and 4 and Grade 5 and 6.

Prizes will be presented at one of the statewide poster exhibitions held during National Water Week (21-27 October 2019.)

"I encourage all students to enter TasWater's poster competition. We hope they come up with some great ideas on how to keep our water systems clean, safe and sustainable," Kate said.
