Contractor Prequalification Process

To conduct business with the TasWater CDO (CDO) you must first be prequalified under the vendor registration system.

To do this please follow the instructions below:

- download the prequalification form [here](#)
- complete all the details requested on the form and compile any required attachments
- submit the completed form, together with required attachments and any further information you wish to provide with respect to your company's technical capability, resource capacity and industry sector/s of interest, to TasWaterCDO.Feedback@taswater.com.au.
- The CDO will review your documents and once satisfied all necessary information has been provided, you'll be notified that your company has been added to the CDO register. If there's any additional information required a CDO representative will contact you as necessary.
- Once registered with the CDO we will then consider your company for tenders in the industry sectors in which you've expressed interest.
- Typically, the CDO will assess the location, type and scale of project being offered for tender and determine, based on the information you have submitted within the prequalification document, whether your company is suitable to be included in an RFT.
- A CDO representative will then contact you to confirm whether your company is interested in bidding on the particular project.
